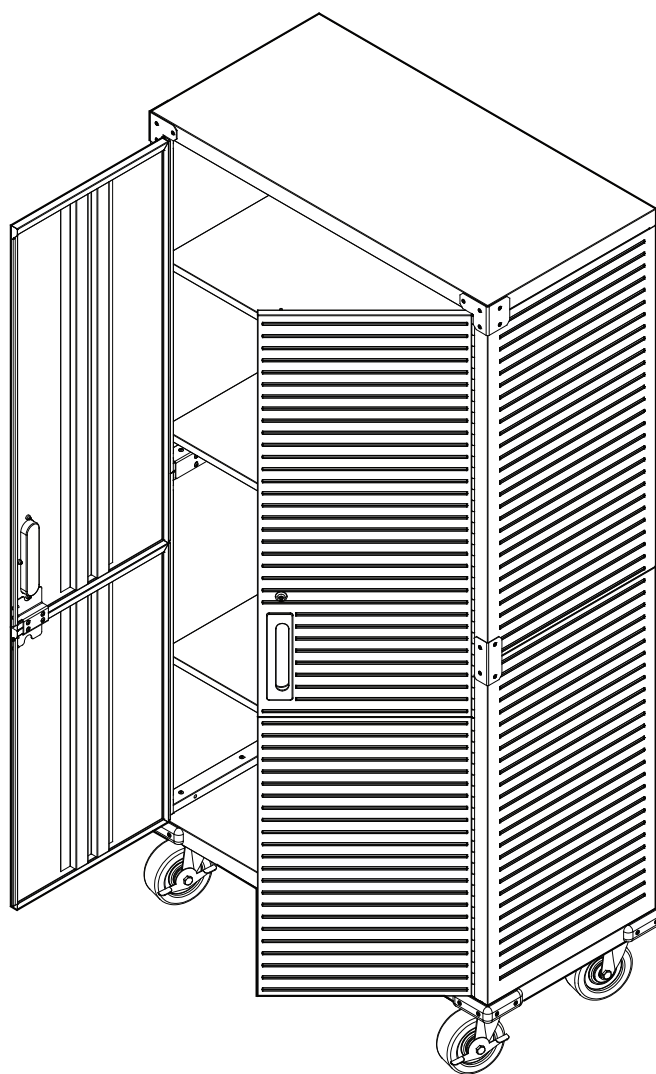

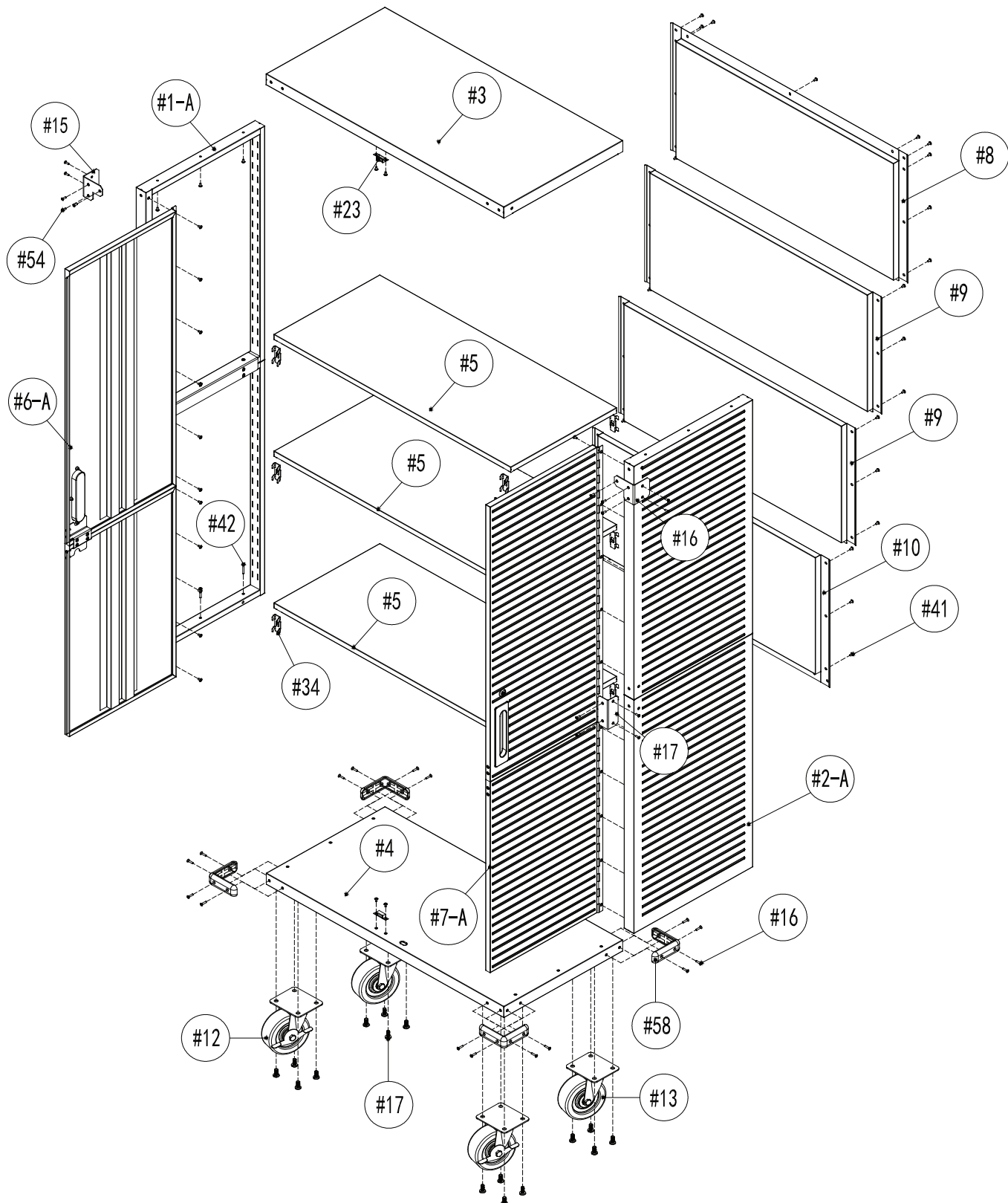

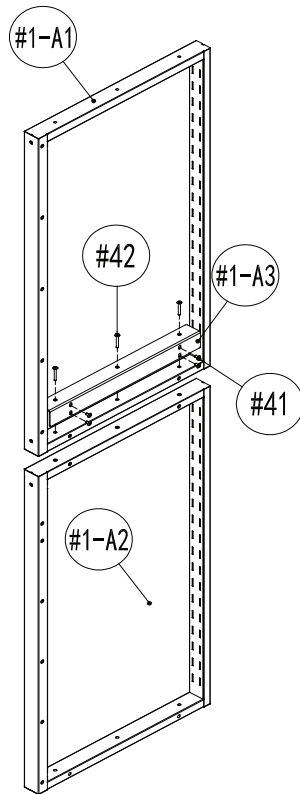
- Place the cabinet on a level surface.

11 ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

Assembly preparation

- Assemble the workbench on a clean, level surface.
- Remove all items from the packaging box and ensure that all parts listed on pages 7-10 are available.
- When installing parts that have more than one screw, tighten all screws by hand before tightening them with the screwdriver provided.
- The package contains an updated product construction designed for ease of transportation while maintaining a rigid structure.

Tip: A magnetic screwdriver is included. If utilizing a power screwdriver, use low torque setting.

Warning: It is recommended to wear gloves during assembly because some parts may have sharp edges.

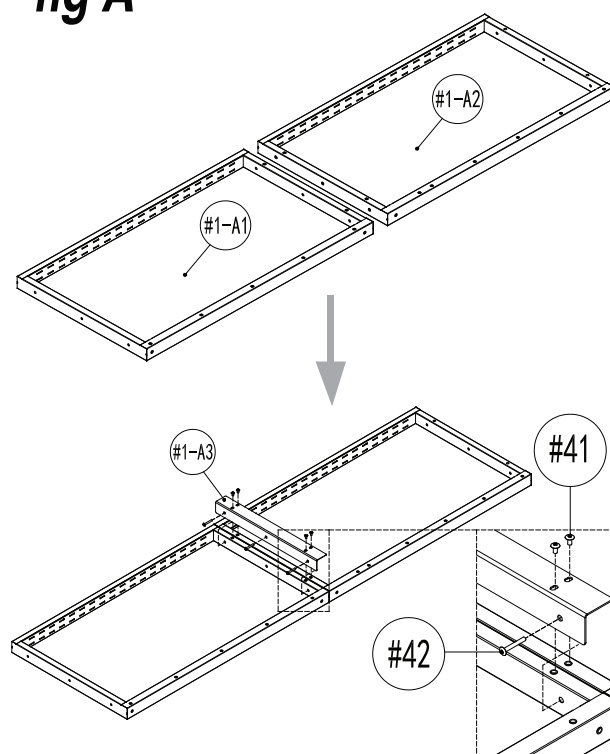
Assembly instructions

fig A

1. Install Left Side Panel. (#1-A)

Position the Left Side - Upper Panel (#1-A1) and Left Side - Bottom Panel (#1-A2) together, place the Side Panel Reinforcement Connection Part (#1-A3) over the touching edges, align screw holes, use 3 (#42) Screw G to tighten from the side, then use 4 (#41) Screw F to tighten from the top side. (*fig A*)

Note: Make sure the Left Side Upper Panel (#1-A1) is aligned with Left Side Bottom Panel (#1-A2) .

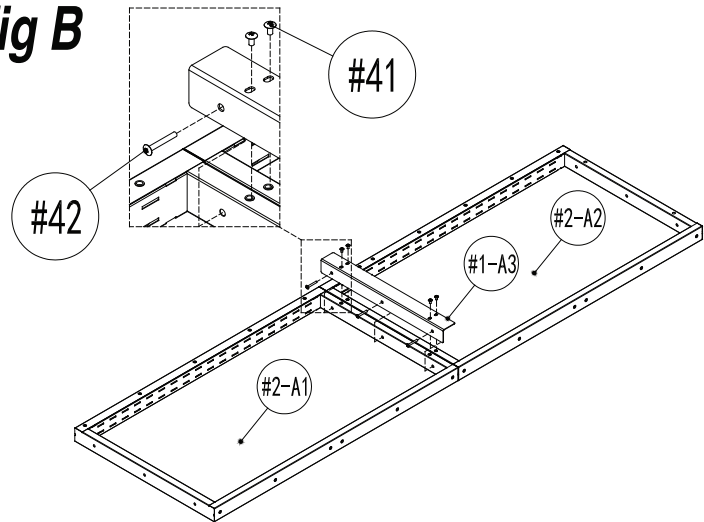

2. Install Right Side Panel.(#2-A)

Repeat Step 1, use (#2-A1) Right Side Upper Panel, (#2-A2) Right Side Bottom Panel, (#1-A3) Side Panel Reinforcement Connection Part 3pcs (#42) Screw G to tighten from the side, then use 4pcs (#41) Screw F to tighten from the top side.
(*fig B*)

3. Install Left Door. (#6-A)

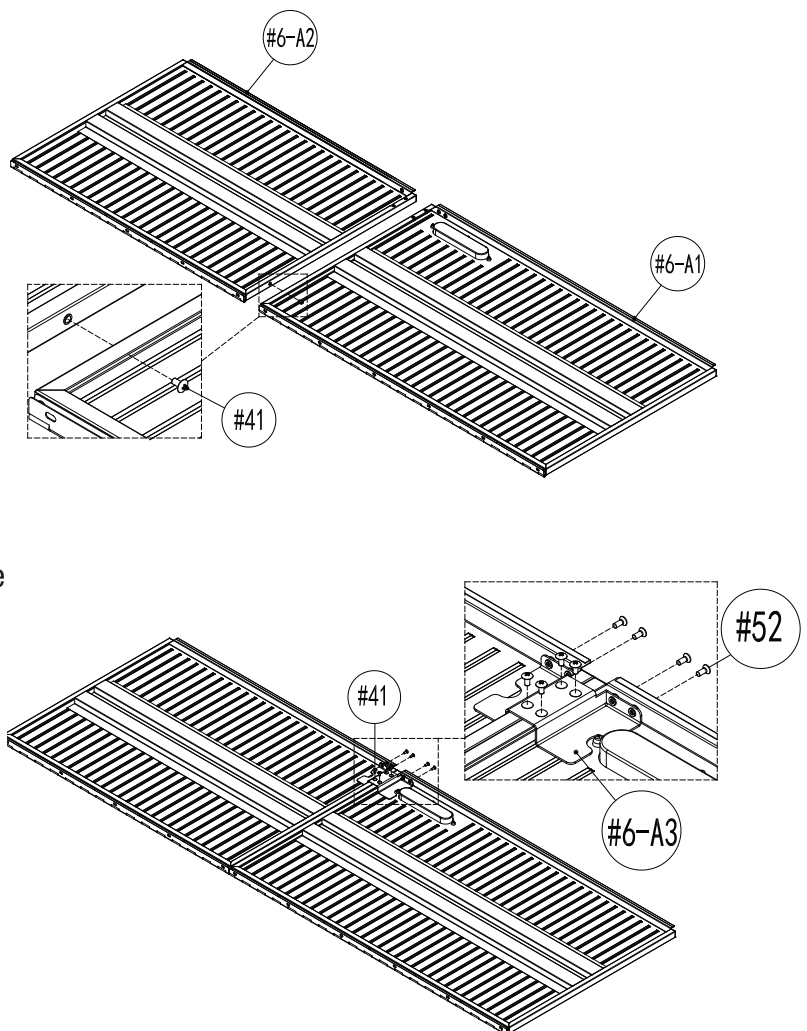
(*fig C*)

1). Place Left Door - Upper Panel (#6-A1) and Left Door - Bottom Panel (#6-A2) together, line up screw holes, use 1 (#41) Screw F to tighten from the side.

2). Put the Door Panel Connection Part (#6-A3) over the touching sides, align the screw holes, use 4 (#41) Screw F to secure from the top, and use 4 (#52) Screw K to tighten from outside edge.

Note: Make sure the Left Door - Upper Panel (#6-A1) is aligned with Left Door - Bottom Panel (#6-A2).

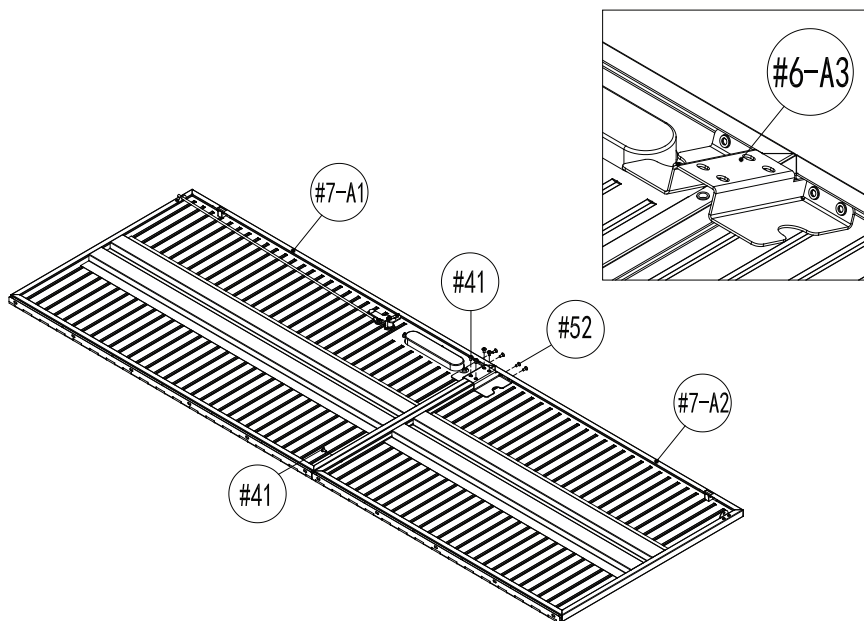

4. Install Right Door. (#7-A)

Repeat Step 3, use Right Door - Upper Panel (#7-A1), Right Door - Bottom Panel (#7-A2), Door Panel Connection Part (#6-A3), use 1 (#41) Screw F to tighten the touching sides, use 4 (#41) Screw F to tighten from the top touching side, and 4 (#52) Screw K to tighten from outside edge. (*fig D*)

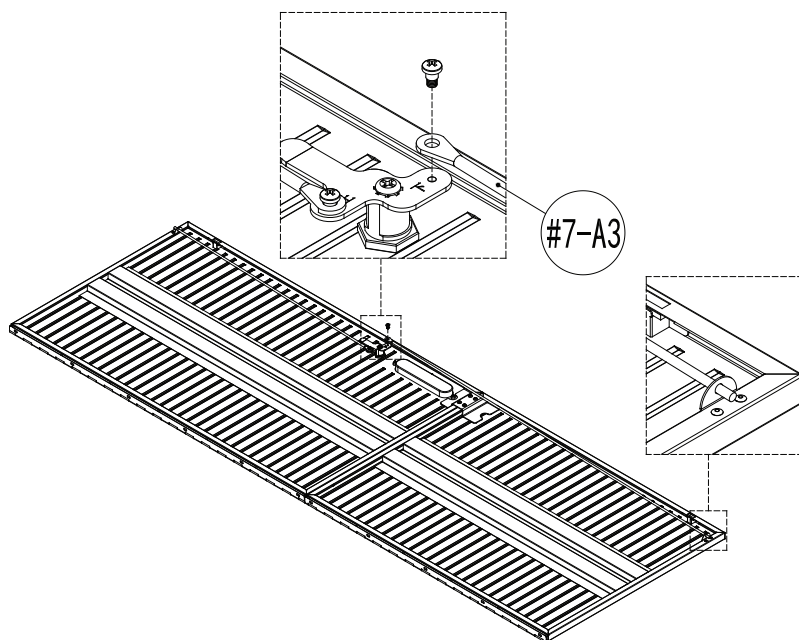
Note: Make sure the Right Door - Upper Panel (#7-A1) is aligned with Right Door - Bottom Panel (#7-A2).



5. Install Key Rod. (#7-A3)

Insert Key Rod (#7-A3) into the bottom tab hole of Right Door - Bottom Panel (#7-A2), unscrew the Pre-assembled (#53) Screw L on the key rod linkage plate, attach Key Rod (#7-A3) by lining up the screw hole and tightening back in the (#53) Screw L. (*fig E*)

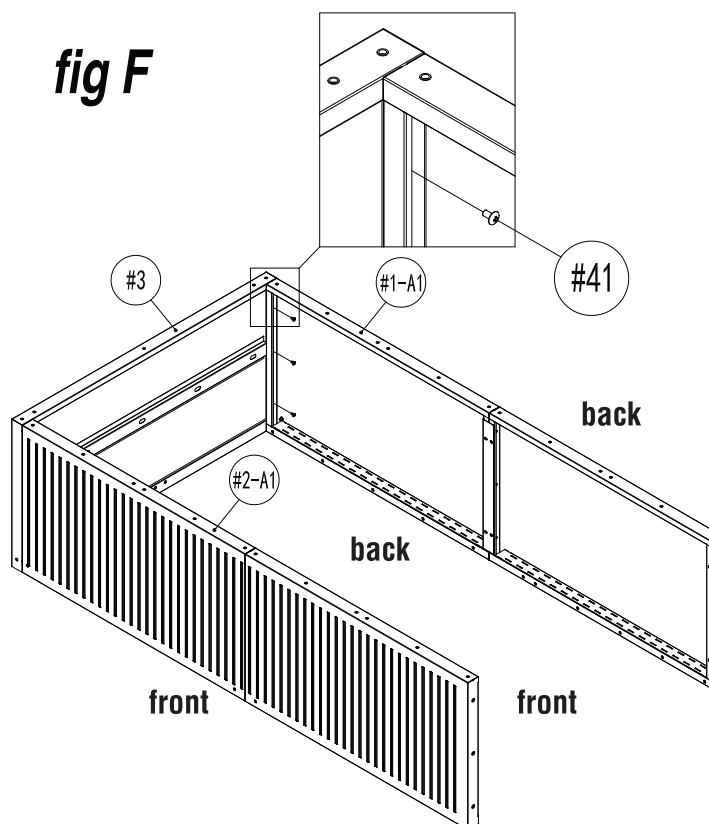

6. Install Top Panel (#3) to Left Side Upper Panel (#1-A1) and Right Side Upper Panel (#2-A1).

Connect the Top Panel (#3) to Left Side Upper Panel (#1-A1) and Right Side Upper Panel (#2-A1). Make sure the front of the panel is facing downward. Align screw holes, use 6 (#41) Screw F to tighten. (*fig F*)

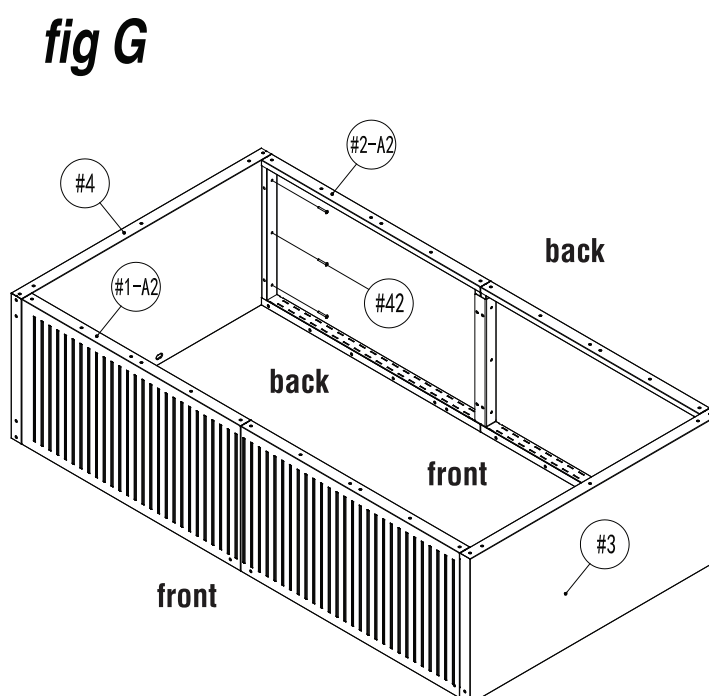
Note: Make sure the bottom corners of Left Side Upper Panels and Right Side Upper Panels (#1-A1, #2-A1) are completely aligned with the back and front corners of Top Panel (#3), before tightening the screws.



7. Install Bottom Panel (#4) to Left Side Bottom Panel (#1-A2) and Right Side Bottom Panel (#2-A2).

Connect the Bottom Panel (#4) to Left Side Bottom Panel (#1-A2) and Right Side Bottom Panel (#2-A2). Make sure the front of the bottom panel is facing downward. Align screw holes, use 6 (#42) Screw G to tighten. (*fig G*)

Note: Make sure the bottom corners of Left Side Bottom Panel and Right Side Bottom Panels (#1-A2, #2-A2) are completely aligned with the back and front corners of Bottom Panel (#4), before tightening the screws.

8. Install Back Panels (#8, #9 and #10).

1). Connect the Bottom Back Panel (#10) onto both Bottom of Left and Right Side Panels (#1-A2 and #2-A2) and Bottom Panel (#4), line up screw holes, use 7 (#41) Screw F to tighten.

2). Connect both Middle Back Panel (#9) above Bottom Back Panel (#10). Place the groove of the Middle Back Panel (#9) onto the top edge of the Bottom Back Panel (#10), use 16 (#41) Screw F to tighten.

3). Use 13 (#41) Screw F to install Upper Back Panel (#8) the same way.

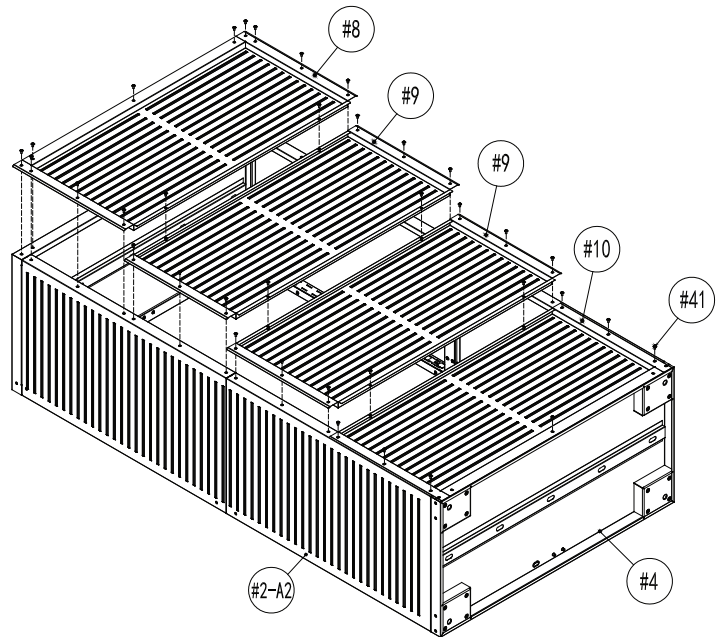
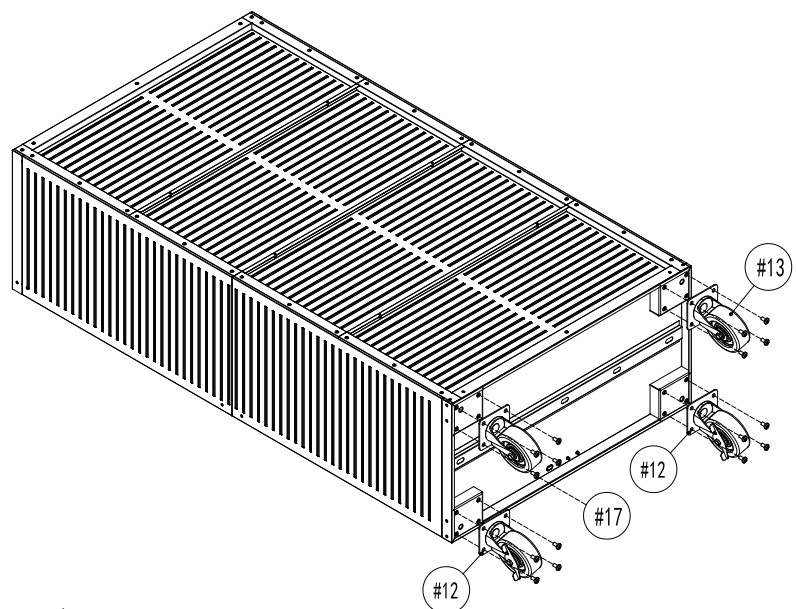

9. Install Wheels (#12 & #13).

(fig I)

Install the Wheels with Brakes (#12) onto the front of the cabinet and screw the Wheels Without Brakes (#13) onto the back of the cabinet. Use 16 (#17) Screws D to tighten.

10. Install Corner Protections (#15, #16 and #17). (fig J)

- 1). Connect the Corner Protection A, B (#15, #16) onto Top of the cabinet, use 10 (#54) Screw N to tighten.
- 2). Connect the Middle Corner Protection (#17) to the middle of Left Side Panel (#1-A) and Right Side Panel (#2-A), use 8 (#54) Screw N to tighten.
- 3). Connect the Bumper (#58) to the corner of Bottom panel (#4), use 16 (#16) Screw C to tighten.

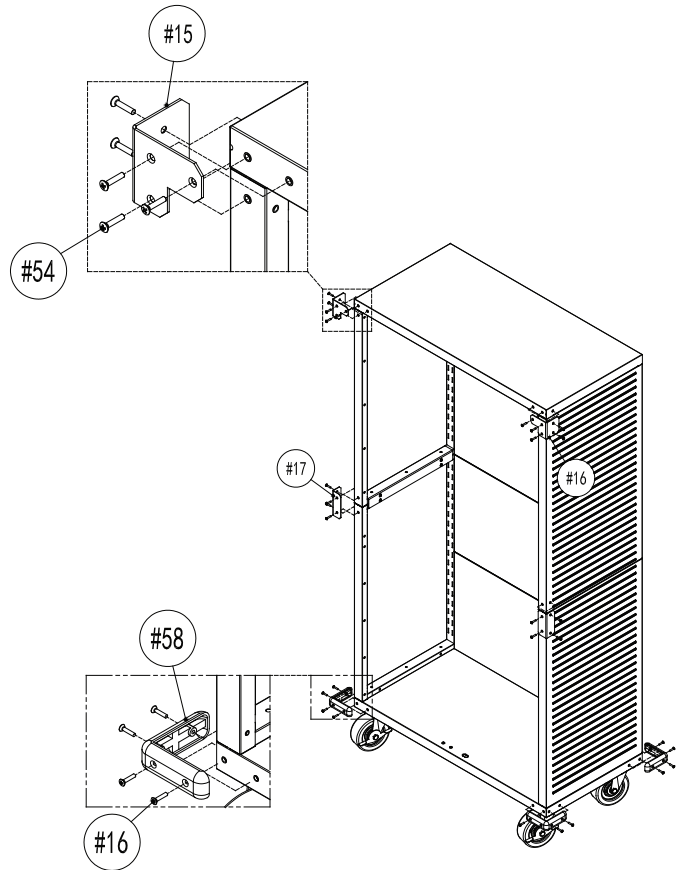
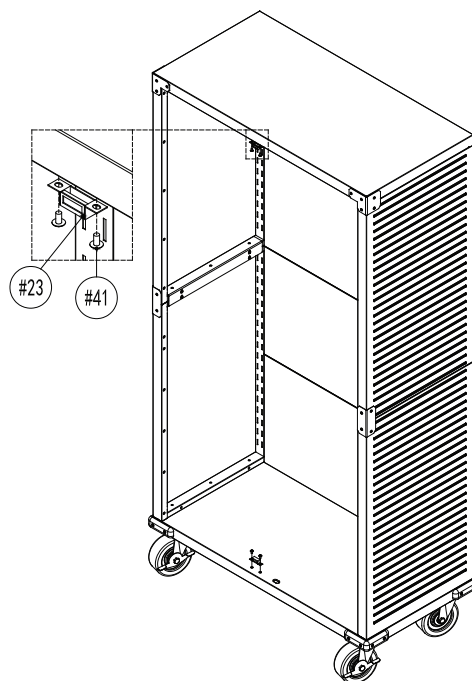

11. Install Magnet (#23). (fig K)

Place Magnet (#23) onto Top Panel (#3) and Bottom Panel (#4) facing the front, use 4 (#41) Screw F to tighten.

12. Install Left and Right Doors (#6-A, #7-A).

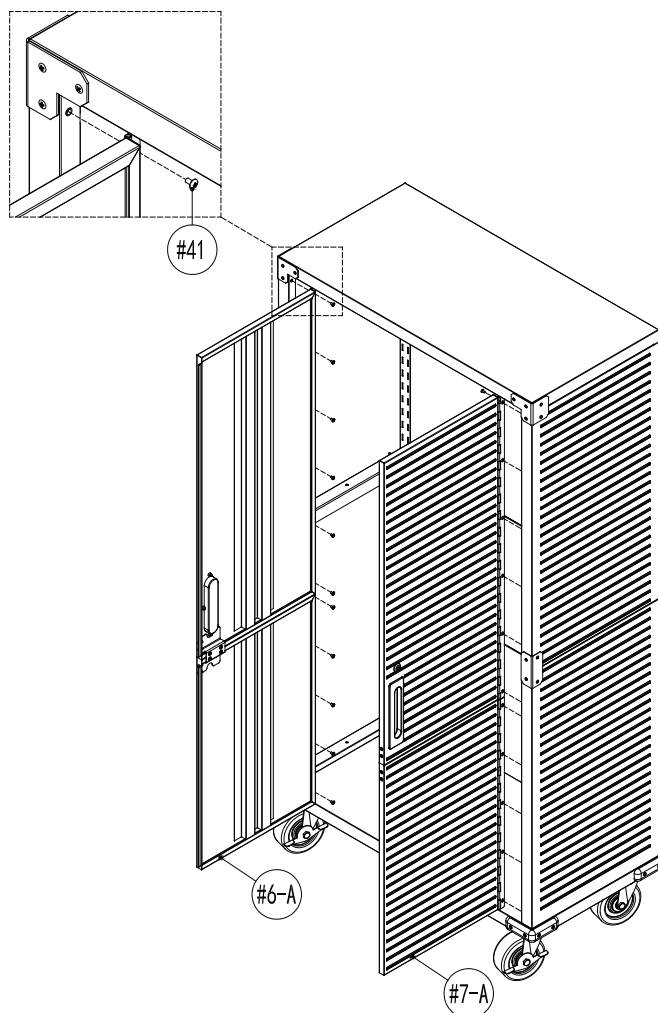
(*fig L*)

- 1). Attach Left Door (#6-A) to Left Side Panel (#1-A), use 11 (#41) Screw F to tighten.

Note: The screw holes on the door hinges have a slight spacing, enabling the door to be adjusted and centered in the door frame. Place top, middle and bottom Screws first. Don't tighten screws completely, allowing slight adjustments for leveling door panels later.

- 2). Install Right Door (#7-A) the same way.

13. Install Middle Shelves (#5). (*fig M*)

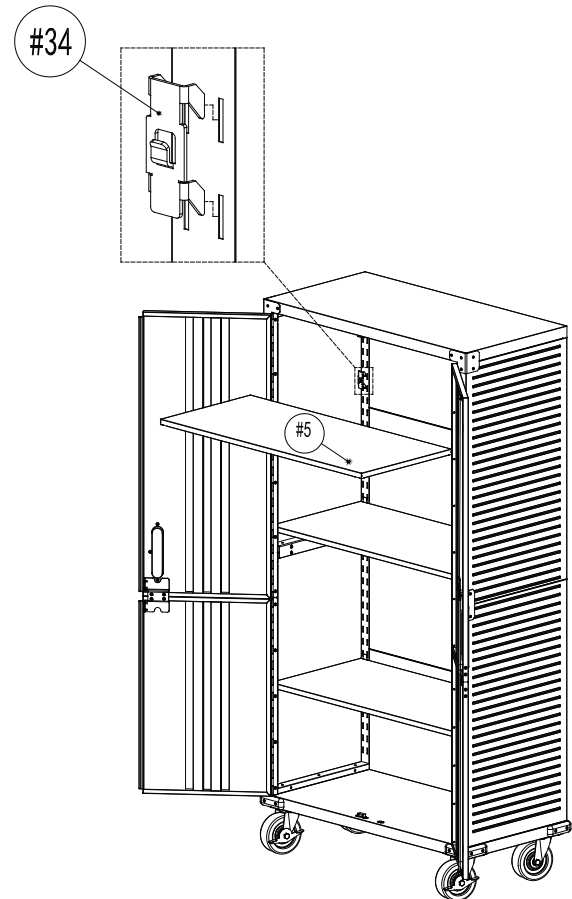
1). Select the height for the Middle Shelves (#5). Place 1 of (#34) Hook into the hook slots where each corner of shelf should be placed. Make sure the hooks are positioned at same height.

2). Put the Middle Shelf (#5) into cabinet and lock down onto Hooks (#34).

Note: The Middle Shelves (#5) need a hooks at each corner to support it.

150 lbs. maximum loading for each shelf.

19 WARRANTY



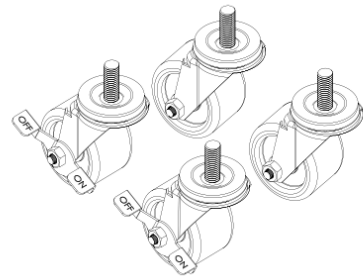
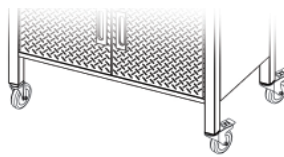
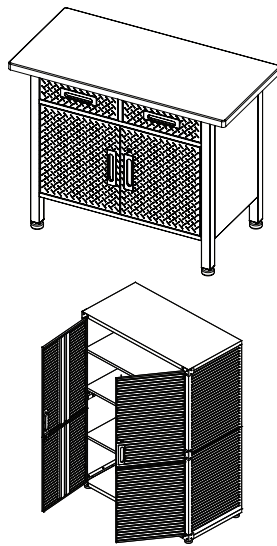

We will bear the cost of any repair or replacement of the product and any costs of labour relating thereto.

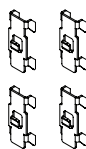
